PROGRAM OVERVIEW

CHOR Youth & Family Services-SafeGuards uses Evidence-Based SMART GOAL Development, trauma focused programming to develop and maintain behavioral safety for children, adolescents, and the community.

The premise of the program is that early detection and intervention of aggressive social behaviors can prevent the development of lifelong deviant and irresponsible behavioral (and potentially criminal) patterns.

The initial forensic evaluation and assessment period provides the information to make appropriate foster home placements, develop a treatment plan with realistic goals, and clear prediction of placement length and reduction of the risk of future offenses.

CHORYFS-SafeGuards clients receive both treatment and case management services. The agency also utilizes Clinical Polygraphs as part of its supervision of youth placed in the program as well as in-home video monitoring.

The goal of the supervision is to identify and describe the specific type, frequency and seriousness of dysfunctional behaviors so that the most effective interventions can be employed to achieve the most desirable outcomes.
