OUR PHILOSOPHY.....

At **Edison Prep**, we believe that meaningful education begins with understanding the whole child. Serving students in grades 7–12, we combine rigorous academics with therapeutic support to help each student reach their full potential.

Our certified teachers deliver personalized instruction in a small, structured setting designed to meet each learner’s individual needs. We focus on building academic skills, emotional resilience, and personal growth to prepare students for success in school and beyond.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Our school day is structured in collaboration with each student’s therapeutic team, integrating education with treatment plans for a well-rounded support system. Edison Prep partners closely with the Bucks County Intermediate Unit 22 (BCIU 22) and Central Bucks School District to ensure educational continuity and coordination with each student’s home district.

We follow the Central Bucks academic calendar and offer a summer program that extends learning through hands-on activities across core subjects and the arts. Our curriculum is aligned with the Pennsylvania Standards Aligned System (SAS) and is designed to exceed local and state academic expectations.

Our educators hold certifications in a broad spectrum of subjects, including English, mathematics, social studies, sciences (biology, chemistry, environmental education, earth & space science, and general science), family and consumer science, English Language Learner, ELL/ESL, physical education, health, technology, and special education. This wide-ranging expertise enables us to offer a comprehensive and rigorous academic program.

REFERRAL PROCESS

Edison Prep exclusively serves students currently residing in one of CHORYFS’s residential treatment programs. Referrals are made as part of the youth’s therapeutic plan to ensure continued academic progress during treatment.

Enrollment is a collaborative process between Edison Prep, the residential treatment facility, and the student’s home school district. Upon referral, we coordinate with the sending district to gather all necessary academic records, including transcripts, IEPs, and recent assessments.

Each referral is carefully reviewed by our admissions team to determine the best academic placement and support services. Once accepted, the student begins their academic program in alignment with their treatment plan, with regular updates provided to the home district to support reintegration following discharge.

- ✓ Male students grades 7-12

FUNDING SOURCE.....

Funding comes mainly from the budgets of the students' sending districts. Additional funding is secured through federal programs such as Title I, as well as grants like PACTT, and other targeted initiatives. These resources enable the school to offer quality, evidence-based, individualized, and small-group instruction.
