OUR PURPOSE.....

CHOR Youth & Family Services Acute Partial Hospitalization Program (APHP) is a psychiatric program providing stabilization and treatment for children ages 5-18. The children who attend are experiencing severe psychiatric symptoms and emotional disturbance. The program operates year-round and consists of highly-structured therapy for 6 hours a day, 5 days a week.

OUR PHILOSOPHY.....

The program is designed to treat clients and their family members in a holistic manner. The treatment team is made up of diverse professionals from psychiatry, social work, counseling, and nursing. The treatment team implements and evaluates individualized care for each client.

CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION.....

Partial Hospitalization must be recommended as the most clinically appropriate and least restrictive service available for the client referred to **APHP**. In addition, the referred individual must demonstrate severe symptoms (problematic behavior and/or severe functional impairment) in one or more of the following areas:

- ✓ Impulsivity and/or aggressive behavior
- ✓ Affect/functional impairment
- ✓ Psychosocial functional impairment
- ✓ Thought impairment or cognitive impairment (other than intellectual disability)

SERVICES PROVIDED.....

- Individual, group, & family therapy
- Psychiatric evaluation
- Medication management
- Biopsychosocial assessment
- Behavioral assessment
- Substance abuse screening
- Individual mental health treatment planning
- Coordination of care
- Community outreach

LENGTH OF STAY.....

The length of stay varies based on the individual needs of the client. The typical length of stay is 3 to 4 weeks. Our program maintains a close working relationship with the **CHORYFS's Residential Programs**, which can provide a number of intensive ancillary services, if necessary.
