Our center encourages its members to take leadership roles through participation in center run committees and all members take part in activities offered. This way, the center belongs to all its members!

***\*NOTE: Depending on the seriousness and circumstances, you may be asked to leave the Center if you cannot adhere to the rules.***

1. Possession or use of illegal drugs or alcohol is NOT permitted.
2. NO weapons or hazardous materials allowed.
3. NO smoking allowed in the center nor in front of the building.
4. We will NOT tolerate verbal, physical or written threats or lewd language - if you do, you will be asked to leave.
5. Be respectful and considerate to others.
6. DO NOT gamble or borrow money, cigarettes or any other personal items from consumers or staff members.
7. All consumers attending the Center must be well groomed and dressed appropriately.
8. Please consume all non-purchased food and drinks before you leave or only take what you can eat/drink.
9. The office phone is for staff only unless you have an emergency. Please limit your phone use to five minutes.
10. Office areas are for Circle of Friends staff only.
11. Please DO NOT bring food or drinks into areas outside of the dining room.
12. Use care with the television, radio and newspapers so others can enjoy them.
13. Feel free to ask for assistance with the operation of any small appliances located at the Center.
